Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings from cold, rainy west Tennessee. We arrived home a few days ago from Pine Bluff, AR where upon our arrival it quickly turned cold and began to rain. It seems as though we brought the rain with us as we drove through it the entire 4 hour trip home. Fall weather has finally arrived and we have begun putting away all of our summer clothes knowing that the next time we pull them out it will be on an entirely different continent. This week we are finishing up our last mission conference for the year. We have been in three over the last two months, and we have three scheduled during January.

Much has taken place since our last prayer letter. The paperwork for our visas were submitted just after our last letter. Within a week, we received a phone call from a lady at the Portuguese Consulate's office who told us that rules had recently changed making the cost of our visas drop significantly. She asked that we send her a check for our visas and our marriage license and she would promptly process our paperwork. Praise the Lord! Well, about a week later, we received another phone call, and we were informed that, in order to enter the country as missionaries, we must have an invitation from an existing church that is recognized by the Portuguese government. On the mainland of Portugal, there are only two independent Baptist churches that are recognized by the government. We were put in touch with the pastor of one of these churches, and after some prayer and research on their part, we were granted a letter of invitation into the country. Praise the Lord, again. We are praying that we will be approved by the first of December.

It has now been a year since we began preparing for the field and the Lord has raised 87% of our necessary support. However, the US dollar/Euro exchange rate seems to worsen everyday, with it now taking \$1.43 to purchase a single Euro.

The Lord recently answered one of our prayers concerning laborers in Portugal. We have been praying that God would send someone to come help us in the ministry. Last year, Ms. Dawne Hart began raising support to go to Portugal and work with her parents who were missionaries there. Since then, the Lord has changed her parents' field of service, sending them to Africa. With her parents leaving, she was unsure about who her new ministry partners would be. Ms. Dawne visited us in our home where we prayed and spoke about the ministry. We now feel that it is the Lord's will for us to work with each other. Her plans are to arrive in the spring of '08. Pray that she meets this goal.
